**Teen killed at McDonald's after fight over sauce**

WASHINGTON: A 16-year-old girl was stabbed to death at a McDonald's outlet in Washington, DC, after a fight over sweet-and-sour sauce, as per a report in The Washington Post. The teenager, Naima Liggon, was killed by another 16-year-old at around 2am on Saturday. She is the 13th person below the age of 18 to be killed in the US state so far this year, the outlet further said. Her attacker has been charged with second-degree murder and held without bail. Several counties in Florida ordered urgent evacuation after Hurricane Idalia on Tuesday turned more deadly after passing Cuba.

out" to prepare for Idalia, and warned that the storm could be "especially destructive." Idalia is taking almost the same path of Hurricane Ian that rammed into Florida 11 months ago causing deaths and widespread damage.

On Tuesday morning, Idalia was about 500 km south-southwest of Tampa. It had maximum sustained winds of near 130 kmph, making it a Category 1 hurricane.

The storm could produce a life-threatening storm surge along much of Florida's Gulf Coast, authorities warned. The National Hurricane Center is finding it difficult to predict where exactly Idalia will make landfall as the hurricane is behaving erratically. A little wobble to the east or the west could move its center from the less-populated Big Bend toward Tallahassee to the north or Tampa to the south.

Florida Gov. Ron DeSantis has deployed 5,500 members of the National Guard and said "Almost every time they've updated this over the last couple of days, they've said it's going to get stronger. So buckle up."

**Donald Trump and 18 allies to be arraigned on Sept 6 in Georgia**

Former US president Donald Trump and 18 of his allies have now got a trial date. They will be arraigned on Sept. 6 before Fulton County Superior Court Judge Scott McAfee for allegedly conspiring to overturn Georgia's 2020 election results.

In the federal case, a judge ruled Monday that the trial against Trump will begin March 4, 2024, a day before the Super Tuesday primaries. Special counsel Jack Smith had proposed a January 2024 start date, while Trump, who is running for president, sought to begin the trial after the 2024 election, in April 2026.

In the Georgia case, all the 19 defendants are accused of violating Georgia's Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organisations (RICO) Act, which penalises activities of individuals engaging in organized crime.

Other charges include conspiring to commit election fraud, conspiring to commit false statements and writings and perjury.

Trump and his allies have denied any wrongdoing. In the hearing in Atlanta, former White House chief of staff Mark Meadows' request to move the Georgia election interference case to federal court concluded without a ruling.

In a surprising move, Meadows rolled the dice testifying about his job at the White House and the chaotic post-2020 election period when Trump (and current Meadows' co-defendant)

sought to overturn the election result to stay in power.

Meadows sought to convince a judge that, as Trump's right-hand man at the White House, his various attempts to block his 2020 election loss to Joe Biden were part of his official government duties.

This has surprised many legal experts. Some described it as a shocking move by legal standards. Criminal defendants often take advantage of their constitutional right and decline to testify as part of their legal proceedings.

And even smarter defendants decline to speak publicly about their case while it's still ongoing. All this will put Trump in further trouble, especially if Meadows testifies on what happened on those chaotic days when his boss tried to overturn the

**Powerful quake rocks Bali and Java Islands**

API/DENPASAR (INDONESIA)

A powerful earthquake and two strong aftershocks rocked Indonesia's resort island of Bali and other parts of the country early Tuesday, causing panic but no immediate reports of damage or casualties. The US Geological Survey said the quake had a preliminary magnitude of 7.1 and was centred in the Bali Sea 181 kilometers northeast of Gili Air, a tiny island near the coast of Lombok Island, next to Bali. It occurred at a depth of 513.5 kilometers.

Indonesia's Meteorology, Climatology and Geophysical Agency said there was no danger of a tsunami but warned of dangers from aftershocks. The agency put the quake's preliminary magnitude at 7.4. Variations in early measurements are common.

The quake was followed by aftershocks of magnitude 5.4 and 5.6 that hit the Bali sea a few minutes later, just before dawn.

**Imran arrested again after being released on bail**

A special court ordered that Khan be kept in 'judicial lockup' and be produced on Wednesday in the cipher case

A high court in Pakistan Tuesday suspended Imran Khan's three-year sentence in the Toshakhana corruption case and ordered his release from jail, but the embattled former premier will continue to remain in prison in the cipher case. A division bench comprising Islamabad High Court (IHC) Chief Justice Aamir Farooq and Justice Tariq Mehmood Jahangiri announced the much-anticipated reserved verdict to release Khan, leaving many to guess if it is a relief ahead of elections or just a stopgap arrangement to fix him in another case. "All we are saying now is that (Khan's) request has been approved," Justice Farooq said, referring to the former premier's appeal against his conviction and prison term.

Khan's Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) party said the decision of the district court has been suspended by the high court. The bench also ordered the release of the 70-year-old former cricketer-turned-politician on the production of surety bonds worth Rs 100,000. However, the former prime minister will continue to remain in

prison as a special court holding his trial in the Official Secrets Act directed the Attock Jail authorities to keep him in the "judicial lockup" and produce him on August 30 before the court.

The case launched earlier this month alleged that Khan and others were involved in the violation of the secret laws of the country. The main issue for supporters of the former premier is if he would be allowed to lead the party in the forthcoming elections. According to experts, it depends on settling the issue of his disqualification. "He was disqualified by the Election Commission of Pakistan after conviction in the Toshakhana case and the disqualification is not affected by mere suspension of sentence," senior lawyer Irfan Qadir said in a TV interview.

**Desi ghee meals, new toilet seat provided in jail to ex-Pak PM**

Pakistan's Supreme Court has been informed that former prime minister Imran Khan is being provided with all facilities in jail according to his "profile and legal status" and served desi chicken and mutton cooked in ghee, a media report said on Tuesday. "The Supreme Court was on

Monday informed that all facilities were being provided to the PTI Chairman Imran Khan at the Attock Jail as per his profile and legal status." The News International newspaper reported. The attorney general's office submitted a report on behalf of the jail superintendent to the Supreme Court after it sought details on his living conditions.

**Aus: Live worm found in woman's brain**

A neurosurgeon investigating a woman's mystery symptoms in an Australian hospital says she plucked a wriggling worm from the patient's brain. Surgeon Hari Priya Bandi was performing a biopsy through a hole in the 64-year-old patient's skull at Canberra Hospital last year when she used forceps to pull out the parasite, which measured 8 centimeters, or 3 inches. "I just thought: What is that? It doesn't make any sense. But it's alive and moving," Bandi was quoted Tuesday in The Canberra Times newspaper.

"It continued to move with vigor. We all felt a bit sick," Bandi added of her operating team. The creature was the larva of an Australian native roundworm not previously known to be a human parasite, named Ophidascaris robertsi. The worms are commonly found in carpet pythons. Bandi and Canberra infectious diseases physician Sanjaya Senanayake are authors of an article about the extraordinary medical case published in the latest edition of the journal Emerging Infectious Diseases. Senanayake said he was on duty at the hospital in June last year when the worm was found. "I got a call saying: We've got a patient with an infection problem. We've just removed a live worm from this patient's brain," Senanayake

told Australian Broadcasting Corp.

The woman had been admitted to the hospital after experiencing forgetfulness and worsening depression over three months. Scans showed changes in her brain. A year earlier, she had been admitted to her local hospital in southeast New South Wales state with symptoms including abdominal pain, diarrhea, a dry cough and night sweats.

Senanayake said the brain biopsy was expected to reveal a cancer or an abscess. "This patient had been treated for what was a mystery illness that we thought ultimately was an immunological condition because we hadn't been able to find a parasite before and then out of nowhere, this big lump appeared in the frontal part of her brain," Senanayake said.

"Suddenly, with her (Bandi's) forceps, she's picking up this thing that's wriggling. She and everyone in that operating theater were absolutely stunned," Senanayake added.
